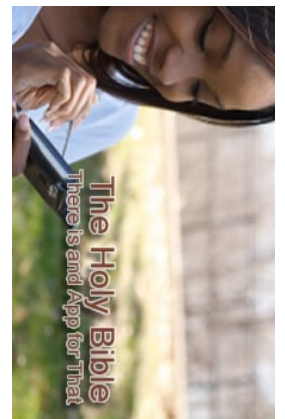


READING THE NEW TESTAMENT IN 2011

If we get hurt by what someone said or did to us then we are instructed to go to them and talk to them, calmly.

The God of Creation looked down upon the man He had created and said that it was not good for him to be alone. We were created for a relationship with God, but we also have a built-in need to be in relationships. Family, friends & Christians brothers & sisters should make us feel loved and blessed. They may take some work to make them healthy and to take out some of the snags that cause problems, but it's worth the effort.

Like restoring an old car or working on a hobby, it may take effort, time and a lot of patience to get them finished so that you can enjoy them. But even the process can be enjoyable, if you have the finished idea in your mind. God has given us relationships so that we can work on them, enjoy them, and be made better by being changed in the process.

To be like God, should always be our goal and desire. And when it comes to relationships He has set us a great example. When mankind rebelled and caused Him such pain, He even regretted creating us, He still kept loving us. He loved us so much that He was even willing to die for us so that He would not have to live for all eternity without us. God knows we aren't perfect but if we ask Him for help and make an effort we can know the blessings of relationships. First with our creator and then with others.

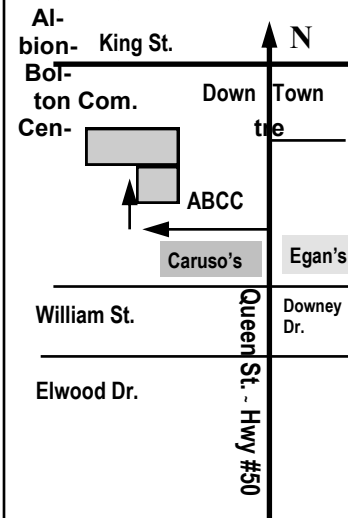
